

-BUS TRIP VACCINATION PROTOCOL-

(Please note these procedures may be modified throughout the pandemic.)

MASKING IS MANDATORY ON BUSES

DOUBLE VACCINATION CONFIRMATION MANDATORY

WITH THE SAFEST CONCERN OF ALL OUR SKI CLUB MEMBERS IN MIND, DOUBLE VACCINATION IS THE ONLY FORM OF ACCEPTANCE THAT IS NOW REQUIRED TO PARTAKE IN RSC BUS TRIP TOURS.

PROOF OF VACCINATION

Ski Club members, age 12 and over must be able to verify they have received two doses of Pfizer, Moderna or AstraZeneca vaccines (or a mixture of two) or a single dose of Johnson and Johnson to be permitted to go on chartered bus trips with The Regina Ski Club.

- The COVID-19 Vaccination Record available through eHealth Saskatchewan's individual MySaskHealthRecord accounts is the **preferred vaccination record** for conformation and will provide the smoothest verification process for travel to intended destinations.
- RSC members 18 and older, will be required to present photo ID matching the name on the vaccination record. RSC members aged 12-17 will be required to show their vaccine record, but not photo id. RSC members under the age of 12 are currently exempt from the policy.
- The Club recommends having a digital copy or screen capture on a smartphone ready for travel..
- Other documents such as the immunization wallet card received at the time of vaccination, COVID immunization records from public health, Armed Forces records or out of province/out of country proof of vaccination will also be considered but may require extra verification.
- Stick it to Covid vaccine stickers will not be accepted as proof of vaccination.

TRIP LEADERS WILL VERIFY DOUBLE VACCINATION OF EITHER QC CODES OR COVID-19 VACCINATION RECORDS.

- The RSC will not be storing any personal health information or vaccination records.
This is a visual verification process only.
- Verification will happen prior to entering the trip bus.
- The bus will arrive at our departure locations one half hour before trip departure. Please allow extra time for vaccination verification.
