Nordic Facilities

After an absence of three years, the annual RSC "trail cleanup/BBQ day" at White Butte Trails will return Sunday October 23rd from 10 Am till about 2 PM, weather permitting. Watch the RSC website for confirmation October 21st. We usually get 35-50 volunteers to clip branches encroaching over ski trails. Work clothes, gloves & long clippers are required. Meet at main trailhead 9:30...ish, form several small crews, guided by grooming crew members, for 2 hours work on various sections of trail. BBQ (hot dogs, drinks) to follow near new shelter.

The SW parking lot at WBT will be expended by the RM of Edenwold in cooperation with PCS (parks) this fall. PCS will also install new road signage to the SW parking lot to spread out winter traffic. Walkers, dogs & snowshoers will be encouraged to migrate to this location, relieving main trailhead congestion.
