

Moose Mountain Provincial Park December 11, 2023


The Snow has been piling up in a little oasis called the Moose Mountains. All



Introduction to Cross Country Skiing with Regina Ski Club, for Free

When: Sunday January 14th from 1:00 to 4:00 PM. Where: Neil Balkwill Civic Arts Centre in Les Sherman Park





Our Ski Club is partnering with the City and Cross Country Saskatchewan to offer people the opportunity to try cross country skiing at no cost. People will join us at the Neil Balkwill Centre where we will equip them with ski boots, skis and poles, provide a quick introduction to cross country skiing, and then get them out onto the Les Sherman ski trails to have fun on skis. No reservation is necessary.

Ski Club members obviously don't need this, so why are we putting it in Sitzmarks? Two reasons:





First, members may have friends r or family who would like to try skiing. This is a chance to get them out at no cost.

Alpine Ski Hills in Saskatchewan





Some of Saskatchewan's best skiing this season are the Saskatchewan ski slopes Most are valleys, cut into the plains 14,000 years ago by melting glaciers. The prairie ski hills are very affordable and have all sorts of amenities!







**Mission Ridge Winter Park**, located in the Qu'Appelle Valley (just 75 km northeast of Regina) has 14 runs, 3 lifts and a tubing park.

### Wapiti Valley Ski & Snowboard Resort

Part of the Saskatchewan River Valley, with 15 runs and a terrain park Location: 50 km north of Melfort Ski

### **Timber Ridge**

A quaint hill with six runs and a snowboard park Location: 3 km south of Big River

#### **Duck Mountain Ski Area**

A whopping 21 runs in the Little Boggy Creek Valley Location: southern fringe of Duck Mountain Provincial ParkTable Mountain Eleven runs, four lifts, tubing and a scenic view of the Battle River Valley

### **Optimist Hill, Saskatoon**

The province's newest winter leisure destination has two lifts, a terrain park and a five-lane







tubing hill.

### Kinsmen Ski and Snowboard Centre, Prince Albert

Just north of the Saskatchewan River by the city of Prince Albert is the Kinsmen Ski and Snowboard Centre in Little Red River Park. There are 3 downhill runs (2 beginner and 1 intermediate), 2 rope tow lifts and a very popular terrain park.

### Asessippi Ski Area

Located on the Manitoba escarpment 290 km northeast of Regina, Asessippi has 26 runs, 2 terrain parks, 4 lit trails at night and 4 lift systems. There is also an evening dining experience. Indulge in a delightful 4 course meal available on the hill!
