The bus will arrive the parking lot located behind the SaskPower building, 2025 Victoria Avenue, at 7:30 AM. Departure will be at 8:00 AM.

Your vehicle is allowed to remain parked there for the day.

Duck Mountain Provincial Park offers beautiful skiing through forest and past small lakes and beaver ponds. The rolling terrain keeps skiing interesting and more than 50 kms of trails ranging from the front 10 on the golf course (3.1 kms) to 25 or 30 kms loops taking in Batka and Rundle Lakes offer choice suitable for all skill levels. The majority of the trails are tracked for classic skiing. The back country trails are hilly and test one's fitness and technical skills. Snowshoers are welcome but encouraged to stay off the groomed trails. In addition to the Log Inn shelter at the parking lot there are 5 shelters: Jack Rabbit, Ski Hill, Rundle Lake, Tamarack and Moose Lake. The trip provides for over 4 hours of skiing time, but skiers may return to the bus at any time.
