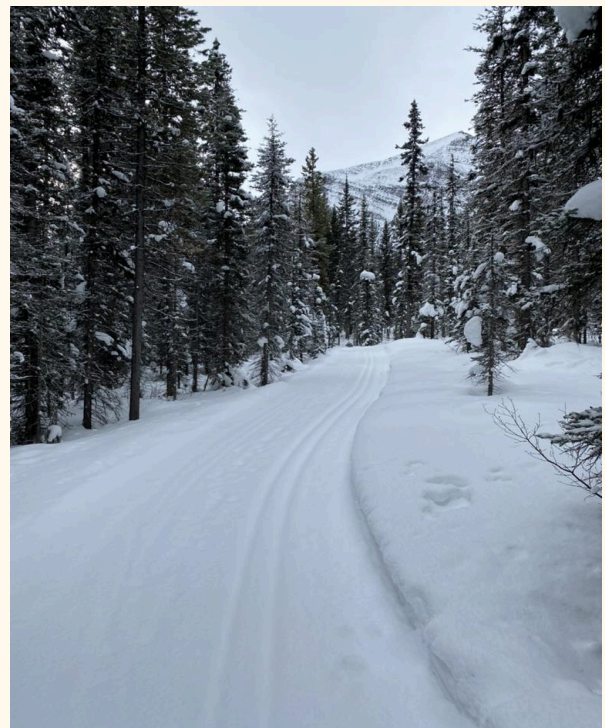

Nordic skiing

While trail and weather conditions will play a role, we are planning one day at Mount Shark and two days at Kananaskis ski trails. The final morning, prior to departure, will be at Canmore Nordic Centre. Prefer the amenities of the day lodge and cafeteria at Canmore Nordic Centre? It is a short taxi ride from our accommodations and can be accessed any day of the trip.

Alpine skiing

Independent travel is required to reach most of the resorts in the area. The charter bus will take alpine skiers to early morning shuttle departures from the Coast Canmore Hotel to the ski resorts in Banff National Park. Alpine skiers can also be transported to/ from Nakiska when the nordic skiers take in Kananaskis trails (tentatively Jan 30 and Feb 1). Alpine lift tickets and shuttle fees are in addition to RSC trip pricing.

Accommodations

Rocky Mountain Ski Lodge reservations (1800 665 6111) are available. Mention the Regina Ski Club and ask about discounts “Stay 3+nights and Save”. Some may prefer to book online through a variety of websites. Cancellations require 72 hours notice except in the event of winter storms that prevent travel and then short notice will be accepted (no penalty).
