Some may be uncertain if a loppet is for them. Rest assured that it is. As a loppet can be defined as “a great gathering of novice to experienced skiers who ski on a specifically groomed trails.” These trails are either classic (diagonal stride) or free (skating technique) style of various distances. Your only challenger is yourself and you pace yourself targeting fulfillment of the moment you're in. Volunteers welcome all levels of skiers to enjoy a highlight of their nordic ski season.

Duck Mountain Provincial Park offers beautiful skiing through forest and past small lakes and beaver ponds. The rolling terrain keeps skiing interesting and more than 50 kms of trails ranging from the front 10 on the golf course (3.1 kms) to 25 or 30 kms loops suitable for all skill levels. Strategically located shelters provide places to stop for lunch or a rest. The trip provides for about 4.5 hours of skiing time. However skiers may return to the bus at any time. Remembering to pace themselves to their ability.
