The annual Duck Mountain Loppet has been a tradition since 1980. Hosted by the Duck Mountain Ski Club, this event is well supported by groomers and other volunteers offering snacks at the huts and excellent trails. A loppet is a tour, not a race, and an opportunity to gather with skiers of all ages and abilities. Celebrate skiing by challenging yourself to a distance and joining many others on the trails, followed by a community meal.

RSC [membership](#) is mandatory to travel on the RSC bus. You must purchase both the RSC bus transportation and separately, your [Duck Mountain Loppet registration](#) (includes your evening meal from the host committee).

Duck Mountain Provincial Park offers beautiful skiing through forest and past small lakes and beaver ponds. The **50km of rolling terrain** keeps skiing interesting. The trails range from the front 10 on the golf course (3.1 kms) to 25 or 30 kms loops taking in Batka and Rundle Lakes. These are suitable for all skill levels. The majority of the trails are tracked for **classic skiing**. The back country trails are hilly and test one's fitness and technical skills. In addition to the Log Inn shelter at the parking lot there are 5 shelters: Jack Rabbit, Ski Hill, Rundle Lake, Tamarack and Moose Lake. The trip provides for over 5 hours of skiing time, but skiers may come and go from the bus at any time.

Most members will bring a lunch to eat on the bus but some may patronize The Duck Mountain Lodge Restaurant (306-542-3466) across the road from the trail head. We will attend the Loppet supper (payment is included in your Loppet registration, purchased from the host committee), returning to Regina between 8-9pm.

Skiers on Regina Ski Club bus trips are friendly, especially to new Club members. We will enjoy each other on the bus, trails and at the Loppet supper.

Please be aware that if a member cancels their day trip, RSC fees (minus the \$10 admin fee and the zone4 fees) are only issued when the seat can be filled off the wait list. [Policies](#) regarding our trips (e.g. cancellations, reservations and refunds) may be found on the RSC website.

Loppet fees purchased from the Duck Mountain Ski Club are non-refundable for any reason.
