

FRED CAMERON MEMORIAL Nordic and Alpine **CANMORE TRIP**

Loading: 11am Grasslands Walmart, 4500 Gordon Road, SE corner of parking lot. Your vehicle may remain parked there for the duration of the trip.

Departure: 11:30am

Talk to your trip leader if you desire a pick up in Moose Jaw, Swift Current or other location along the #1 Highway headed westbound out of Regina.

This Regina Ski Club bus tour offers three days of nordic and/or alpine skiing in the welcoming town of Canmore, Alberta. Regina Ski Club (RSC) [membership](#) is mandatory. Please ensure your activity for this trip and the ski year (alpine, nordic or both) is captured in your member registration.

Trip pricing includes bus transportation and Friday night pizza and salad social. All other expenses (accommodation, meals, lift tickets/ Canmore Nordic Centre trail passes, alpine shuttles (if needed) are your responsibility. Interested in a roommate? Talk to your trip leader.

Nordic Skiing

Snow and trail conditions will dictate our plan. Typically, we enjoy 1 day of skiing at [Mount Shark](#) and 2 days at the [Peter Lougheed](#) Provincial Park. The [Canmore Nordic Centre](#) (CNC) (trail fees are the responsibility of the member) is an option every day. The morning of our return to Saskatchewan, some members will ski CNC or take in the dining/ shopping options in town. Your trip leader will email a more detailed itinerary prior to departure.

Alpine Skiing

The charter bus may take alpine skiers to the resort (Sunshine, Lake Louise or Nakiska) closest to the nordic trails for the day. Alternatively, you can catch an early morning shuttle from the Coast Canmore Hotel to the ski resorts in Banff National Park. Shuttle fees and alpine lift tickets are the member's responsibility. Care should be taken NOT to purchase fees/ lift tickets too far in advance, in the rare event that the RSC bus trip does not proceed.

Social Events

Skiers on RSC bus trips are friendly, especially to new Club members. A pizza and salad social event on Friday (price included) as well a Saturday night group meal is planned. More details will be emailed prior to departure.

New in 2027: The Friday night pizza and salad supper social will be provided with your trip fees. The optional Saturday night group meal is the member's responsibility.

RSC members that choose not to ski are welcome to come along and enjoy the camaraderie on the bus, evening socials and the amenities of the resort communities of Canmore/ Banff.

Accommodations

Most members will stay at [The Rocky Mountain Ski Lodge](#) (RMSL). Our charter bus departs from this location daily. Other Canmore accommodations remain an option however, members would need to make their own transportation arrangements to/from the bus (if necessary).

Rocky Mountain Ski Lodge offers a discount for 3+ consecutive nights. When booking, mention that you are a Regina Ski Club member. As of summer 2026, cancellations require a 72 hour, 3 day notice. The exception may be winter storms when roads are not passable. Please check the current cancellation policy as accommodation fees are the sole responsibility of the member.

Refunds

Refunds, minus a \$10 administration fee and the Zone4 on-line processing fee will be issued for overnight trips cancelled by Regina Ski Club Member(s) when a 2 week notice (14 full days from departure hour) is given OR if the seat(s) can be filled from a waiting list.

Members are encouraged to consider trip cancellation insurance through their insurance agent. However, you will need to confirm RSC trips are covered as we are not a “commercial carrier”.
